



PUBLIC NOTICE

Hyde County implementing changes at the trash convenience sites in Swan Quarter, Engelhard, and Ocracoke on July 1, 2008.

Swan Quarter and Engelhard Trash Convenience Site

New hours

- The sites will be open from 10:00am to 6:00pm Tuesday – Saturday. The sites will be closed on Sunday and Monday.

Items that will have no charge

- Vegetative debris (tress, limbs, etc.)
- White goods (appliances, washer, dryer, etc.)
- Tires
- Recyclables
- Used motor oil

Items that will be charged

- All weighted C & D material at a cost of \$150.00/ton (payable on site).

Ocracoke Trash Convenience Site

Items that will have no charge

- Vegetative debris (tress, limbs, and etc.)
- White goods (appliances, washer, dryer, and etc.)
- Tires
- Recyclables
- Used motor oil

Items that will be charged

- All C & D material will be charged by the size of the load (payable on site).

Light

Heavy

Vehicle/ Pick-up Load

- Half Full	\$10.00	\$20.00
- Full (to sides)	\$15.00	\$30.00
- Over Full (above sides)	\$25.00	\$50.00
- Slates	\$50.00	\$100.00

Trailer Load

Trailer up to six feet

- Half Full	\$20.00	\$40.00
- Full (to sides)	\$35.00	\$70.00
- Over Full (above sides)	\$50.00	\$100.00

Trailer over six feet up to twelve feet

- Half Full	\$30.00	\$60.00
- Full (to sides)	\$50.00	\$100.00
- Over Full (above sides)	\$75.00	\$150.00

If a load contains a substantial number of asphalt or heavy shingles, the site attendant may charge up to 50% surcharge.

Trailers over twelve feet cannot be accepted at the Ocracoke convenience site and may be taken to Swan Quarter or Engelhard sites, but may be accepted at the discretion of the site attendant.

On the mainland there will be a solid waste bill of \$20.00/month added to the water bill and on Ocracoke there will be a bill for \$30.00/month. The curbside collection of trash will be the same as now with the exception of the recyclable items, which will not be picked up at the curbside but will be accepted at the convenience sites. Everyone is encouraged to recycle.
